Literacy

Literacy

Students in K-2 are learning how to write persuasive texts during the first few weeks of this term. We are also trialling a different approach to literacy learning through independent structured activities that allow students to become responsible learners with guidance.

Maths

Students will be learning about position and area over the first few weeks of the term. On Wednesdays we will be continuing on with 3D shapes, time and 2D shapes.

History

This term students in K-2 will be learning about our heritage and local history. In particular looking at how things have changed over time.

Library and Science
