Touch Football Gala Day

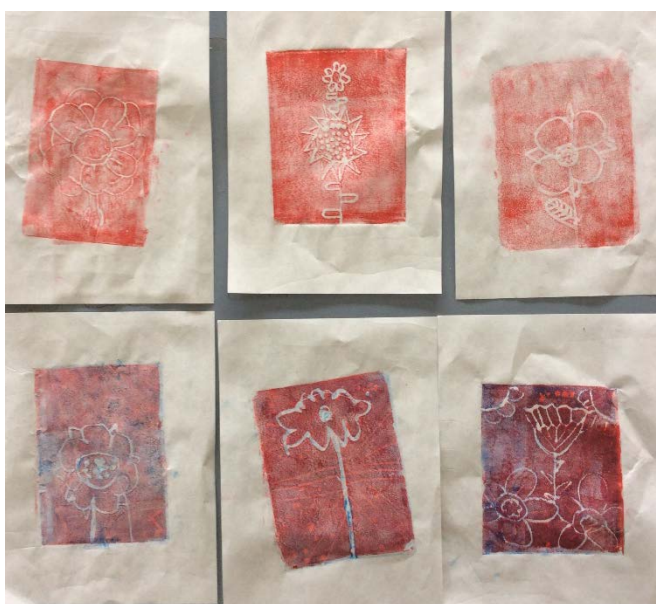
