Literacy

Mrs Gerhardy's class are continuing their fairytales and a lot of the students are up to publishing their stories. These stories will be read

Literacy

The students will be entertained by the Sydney group Dr Stovepipe who perform Gypsy Swing, Ragtime and Hot Jazz.

“Down a dusty road from the 1930s comes Doctor Stovepipe, a rollicking, old-time ensemble of guitar, bass, fiddle and sweet vocal harmonies. Each appointment is a swinging dose of fun, and a demonstration of how songs evolve and change as they are passed on from one musician to the next. Students learn how the simplest sounds and stories can be turned into toe-tapping tunes; and that when it comes to making music, no road map is required.”

After the performance students will be split into the stage groups for some ball games and round robin tennis matches.
