## **Mrs Morey and Mrs Gerhardy Learning News** Literacy

We are finishing up our Sydney Excursion slide and brochure assessments before our excursion next week. Students are very excited about the opportunities and places they will see while we are in Sydney.

## **Maths**

In Maths with Mrs Gerhardy, students are looking at position and length and with Mrs Morey; they will be doing fractions and decimals. We will continue to practise times tables at the start of the lesson for quick recall of the facts.

In Art students have created beautiful Sydney Harbour pictures depicting the Vivid light festival. They all enjoyed creating these lovely works.

## **Mrs Menz and Mrs Noske Learning News** Literacy

Stage 1 Have been working with the letter combinations that make the sound t and or. We have been focusing on using interesting sentences in our writing by using adjectives to make it more interesting for the reader. We have been extending our writing through recount text, making sure that we include something that happens at the start, middle and end of the story.

Early Stage 1 In writing, they are checking that their sentences make sense and begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop. They have also been retelling the story with something that happened at the beginning, middle and end.

## **Maths**

We have been focusing on Multiplication, 3D shapes and Mass over the past two weeks. They have been looking at how to heft objects to make an estimation of what items weigh. We have also been using informal units of measure of paddle pop sticks to weigh objects on the balance scales. We have been looking at the properties of 3D objects and where we find them in our environment.

## Science

Students have been working very hard on our subject Material World. Looking at man made structures and discussing the materials they are made from and the suitability of the materials for the structures. Stage 2 and 3 have been using a program called e. studio to create a project proposal. They will build a model of their shelter over the coming weeks.

Our relay team did very well on the day of the Southern Riverina Athletics Carnival, gaining second place. This will see Tylah, Molly, Jessica and Alice compete at the Riverina Carnival on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> September. Tylah has also made it through for Junior Boys High Jump.
