School Swimming

All students will attend school swimming at the Oasis in Wagga Monday to Friday of Week 10. The bus will leave school at 10.30am each morning with swimming lessons from 11.30am to 12.30pm. Students will return by 1.30pm. Students will be having some 'free time' at the pool on Friday 16th Dec (last day of school), on this day the us will return by 2.30pm. There will be no 'Special lunch' on Wednesday of week 10. We will ensure students have eating time before boarding the bus and again on arriving back at school. The school will cover the cost of the lessons and bus hire with students asked to cover the cost of pool entry - \$4.50 per student per day = \$22.50 per student.

Mostly for the last week or so the 3-6 students have been busily completing many assessments while their teachers are marking them, prepping for, and writing Semester 2 reports.



