Dear Families,

This year we welcome two new kindergarten students Summer and Caden to our K-2 classroom who join Jayden, Eleanor and Rachel and we are off to a great start in our learning so far.

In Literacy we will be delivering the InitiaLit Program from Monday to Friday. Year 1 will be given readers for each day of the week. Kindergarten will receive readers around week five once they know their first group of letters (m, s, t, a, p, i, f, r). I would encourage families to read with their child once a day.

In Numeracy, we are learning about 'Whole Number' concepts and will be doing activities that reinforce students' understandings in this area.

In Visual Arts we have started to create a 'Picasso Face' which focuses on Cubism and so far, students' efforts are fantastic!

Our Science focus is 'Living Things' and this week we ventured out into the playground to determine what we could see that was Living and Non-living and then recorded our findings.

Library is held on a Wednesday with Mrs Mulholland and students can borrow up to 3 books each week.

We also do Fundamental Movement Skills each day and the students have been learning some yoga poses and developing their skills in throwing, catching and balance.

Dear Families,

Welcome back to our students! It was so lovely to see all of your smiling faces and your enthusiasm to be back at school for another year of learning.

For 3-6 History we have commenced a unit called Before Contact which is about what life was like for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples prior to European settlement in Australia.

For 3-6 Science as part of the Living Things strand, we began looking at a unit about Food and Fibres. Specifically, the journey or process these things undertake to arrive for sale at the supermarket or the shops some of which makes it onto our plates to be eaten.

The focus for 3-6 Health currently is How can we include others and build respectful relationships. This week we looked at identifying strengths in ourselves and others.

For the Second strand of 3-6 Maths (Measurement and Geometry plus Data and Chance). Students have begun by completing some pre-assessments. Next week we will commence the topic of 2D Space followed by Angles.

In K-6 Library we are utilising some wonderful Indigenous resources called "Our Land, Our Stories". This week we learnt more about the Aboriginal Flag, its history, its connection to culture and what the colours black, red, and yellow represent. A Luritja artist named Harold Thomas designed it in 1971.

We will be offering our delicious and much enjoyed Wednesday Lunches again this year.


